IRAS is an interdisciplinary and multi-faith society of pioneering scientists and religious thinkers together with other interested persons. This year's topic:

CREATIVITY, NON-CONFORMITY, AND MADNESS

How can criteria be set for what is normal and what is deviant? What is it that establishes a work of art as beautiful or ugly, a scientific discovery as fact or unproved theory, a religious experience as authentic or heretical, a person as sane or mad? In what ways can criteria formulated in one area of life provide insight in other areas? How does the mildly/extremely deviant person contribute to creative change and/or maintain stability? How much and when is deviance creative and/or destructive?

Speakers will address this theme from the points of view of religion, science, psychology and the arts. Other speakers will attempt to tie the threads among these disciplines. A major departure in this conference will be creative workshops which will meet for eight hours each and offer opportunities for participants to explore their own creativity. Further creative options will be experienced in free university format, an extensive array of Elms and other evening activities. A children's program will be available for 5 to 16 year olds.
