The kitchen cannot handle individual dietary needs beyond the selections listed above.</p> <p><b>ROOM CHOICES AND RATES (INCLUDING MEALS):</b> <b>1</b> Single, \$972 (very few available); <b>2</b> Double, \$754 (most single beds, a few double beds available—identify preference); <b>3</b> Triple, \$710 (price based on adult occupancy); <b>4</b> Motel Unit \$848 (twin beds, private toilet, double occupancy only). All prices include 15% gratuity for island staff. Rates for children: under 6, \$0; 6–11, \$452; 12–17, \$600. Children living in motel rooms at parent’s request will be charged adult rates.</p> <p>No room request can be guaranteed. A second room choice may be indicated. Asterisk (*) and explain choice if urgent. If no roommate preference is given, roommates will be assigned. Indicate whether you want your teenager housed with you or with his or her own age group. The cost of room and board is in addition to the conference fee and is paid on the island. <p><b>CONFERENCE FEES:</b> <b>Adult registration fee</b> (18 and over) \$150 plus a \$150 room deposit per person 6 or over at the time of the conference. <b>Children ages 3</b> (must be toilet-trained) <b>to 17</b>, \$150 for the <i>Archi Pelagos</i> Program. IRAS members who register <b>by April 10</b> (and nonmembers who apply for membership <b>by April 10</b>) receive preference for registration and a \$25 discount. [Annual dues, including a subscription to <i>Zygon</i>, are \$70 for individuals, \$80 for couples: both receive the registration discount.]</p> <p><b>Maximum registration per family</b> is \$750 <i>plus room deposits</i>. <b>No registration fee for children under 3. Conference fees and room deposits must be paid with registration.</b> IRAS provides no program or child care for children who are not 3 by August 1. Parents are responsible for their care at all times. An evening (8–11 P.M.) hall monitor service for children under eight is provided by Star Island staff at no charge. Fees less 20% (and full room deposit) are refundable if registration is canceled before June 1.</p>	<p><b>ARRIVAL:</b> Star Island is reached by a ferry boat, the <i>Thomas Lighton</i>, operated by The Isles of Shoals Steamship Company. It departs from the Market St. dock in Portsmouth, NH. Information regarding schedules, fares, and parking will be provided at the time of registration.
